### Newburyport, Ma

\*Rich in maritime history and nestled on the shores where the Merrimack River meets the Atlantic, the Greater Newburyport area is comprised of diverse shops, restaurants and small businesses. Plum Island offers miles of public sandy beaches and the Parker River National Wildlife Refuge, home to over 800 species of birds, plants and animals on 4,662 acres. Sandy Point on the southern tip of Plum Island is a State Park and a wonderful place to swim, sun yourself or go tide pooling.

### Haverhill, MA
